YELLOWHAB enrolls students through a step-by-step admissions process. YELLOWHAB makes all enrollment decisions in accordance with its policies and procedures, including its Nondiscrimination Policy as to Students. Lottery eligibility requires that prospective students meet certain preliminary eligibility guidelines. YELLOWHAB then invites prospective students and families to consider YELLOWHAB's offerings to determine whether its programs meet the student's needs. YELLOWHAB offers a 1:10 explorer to educator ratio that promotes personalized learning. We look to project based instruction and encourage 1:1 technology in school and at home. Through our holistic assessments, we focus on social emotional learning, academic learning, and personal growth, and support these initiatives through school-wide social and emotional support programming. YELLOWHAB recognizes some interested prospective students may need educational supports that YELLOWHAB does not provide. Families are encouraged to review and consider services currently offered and not currently offered prior to applying to YELLOWHAB's lottery. By applying to YELLOWHAB's lottery, each family attests that their child's needs align with YELLOWHAB's offerings. Neither successful lottery submissions nor draws for the waitlist or completion of necessary documentation are quarantees of enrollment. Final admissions decisions are at YELLOWHAB's sole discretion. Students are enrolled only after families complete and execute the Student Enrollment Agreement. Misrepresentation of student needs may result in dismissal from YELLOWHAB.

YELLOWHAB meets its explorers at their present levels and invites them to immerse in hands-on learning through our thematic curriculum. We support our students' personal and academic growth. We welcome all interested families to learn more about YELLOWHAB and our lottery and enrollment process. Presently, YELLOWHAB works with its resources and supports to offer limited specialized services.
